Omaha Philatelic Society's 2026 Centennial Celebration Art Contest Submission Criteria

1. Theme

- **Required:** Artwork must reflect the theme of the Omaha Philatelic Society, its centennial celebration, and/or local Omaha stamp collecting in general. Please include the text, Omaha Philatelic Society, and reference to its centennial, as a part of the whole design.
- **Optional:** Include a short artist statement (100 words max) explaining the artwork's connection to the theme.

2. Originality

- All entries must be original works created by the submitting artist.
- No Al-generated art, stock images, or copied material allowed.

3. Medium

- Acceptable media: Digital illustration, watercolor, ink, acrylic, pencil, or mixed 2-dimensional media.
- If submitting physical art, it must be scanned or photographed at high resolution.

4. Format & Dimensions

- Design must be scalable to small format use, such as:
 - Stamp label size: ~1.5" x 2" (38mm x 51mm)
 - Cachet envelope area: up to 6.5" x 3.5" (standard #6 or #10 envelope size)
- Submitted file requirements (for digital or digitized work):
 - Format: JPEG or PNG
 - Minimum resolution: 300 dpi
 - **Resolution Requirement**: All digital or digitized artwork submissions must be at a minimum resolution of **300 DPI (dots per inch)** at approximately **5 inches or more on the shortest side**. As a general guideline, this means your image should be **at least 1500 pixels** on its shortest edge, regardless of aspect ratio. Higher resolution images are encouraged for best print quality.

5. Orientation

• Artwork can be **portrait or landscape**, but designs should work in **stamp or envelope context**.

6. Color

- Full color encouraged; black and white or monochrome also acceptable.
- Ensure good contrast and clarity at reduced sizes.

7. Text Elements

- If text is incorporated in digital artwork, it must be embedded.
- The stamp club reserves the right to add postal or commemorative markings as overlays.

8. Age & Eligibility

Open to all ages

9. Deadline & Submission

- All entries must be submitted by November 30, 2025 via email to omahaphilatelicsociety@gmail.com.
- Include:
 - Artist's full name and contact info
 - Title of the artwork
 - Medium used
 - Brief bio (optional)

10. Prizes

• First Place (\$500), Second Place (\$300), and Third Place (\$200) prizes will be selected and awarded by the Omaha Philatelic Society.
